

Mr. Collins, a member of the County Police force for the last six years, was struck when he was in the act of stepping into the patrol wagon at 7th Street Road and Tennessee Avenue to take a prisoner to headquarters.

A brother policeman, who was also assisting with the refractory culprits placed the injured patrolman in the wagon and rushed him to the hospital, where his injuries were found to be internal and from which he died.

Surviving Mr. Collins, who was unmarried, are one sister, Mrs. William Koch, of Highland Park; and four brothers, John, with whom he lived near Fairdale, James, of Highland Park, William and Squire Collins of this place.

The funeral was conducted this (Thursday) afternoon by Rev. T. T. Frazier at the Mt. Holly Methodist church, the brother patrolmen acting as pall bearers and burial was in the new division of Mt. Holly cemetery.

Mr. Collins was a general favorite in this community and his many friends extend sincere sympathy to the bereaved.
