RE: Protest Detail Changes
Special Order #20-046



The current State of Emergency remains in effect. As the COVID-19 pandemic and civil disturbance needs continue to change, we are continuously adjusting our detail requirements based on the needs of the community and the needs of our employees. Effective Wednesday, September 30, 2020, the current protest detail will discontinue. This de-mobilization entails the following:

- Barricade removal will begin late Tuesday night (September 29, 2020) into Wednesday morning (September 30, 2020) for the outer perimeter (2nd Street to 9th Street).
- Barricades will be retained around Jefferson Square Park.
- Off-day rotations will resume. Personnel who would normally be on their RDOs would then be off.
- Employees will again revert to limited vacation approval (up to 40 hours) (refer to Special Order #20-045).
- Employees will revert to normal daily schedules.
- The P2 detail rotation will resume.

All members having computer access are responsible for reading, understanding, and acknowledging receipt of this Special Order, using the PowerDMS Document Management System. Members without computer access will continue to sign an accountability roster, as they have in the past.

All commanding officers will ensure their personnel are made aware of this information.

This Special Order will be posted in each division, section, or unit for a period of ten (10) days. Please refer any questions through the appropriate chain of command.
