



# CRITICAL INCIDENT TIMELINE

## 1 ON-SCENE

The Chief / Executive Staff will provide a brief overview of preliminary information and address any public safety concerns.

Additional correspondence will be made available from our social media platforms.



## 24-72 HOURS

# 2

Identification of involved officers to include current assignment, department photo, and commendations/disciplinary history.

Identification of involved subjects. Per state law, Coroner will release identity of deceased.

# 3

## WITHIN 10 BUSINESS DAYS

Release of Body-Worn Camera footage with general explanation of the investigative process.



## BEYOND 10 BUSINESS DAYS

# 4

Criminal and Administrative investigations continue on all involved, including officers.

Consultation with Commonwealth's Attorney Office for a final disposition.

Performance Review Board; Internal assessment of training and policy needs.





# In-depth process...

## 1 BWC Production:

- Introductory Statement
- Curated video from LMPD
  - \* Video will describe the entire investigative process, will show all relevant camera footage, and will contain relevant dispatch clips.
- RAW video (only edited for sensitive content) will be shared along with the curated video.
  - \*Video will be posted to all LMPD social media platforms



## 2 Investigative Process:

- Public Integrity Unit
  - \* Leads criminal investigation
  - \* Consult with Commonwealth's Attorney Office for final disposition.
  - \* Kentucky State Police conducts investigative review.
  - \* Office of Inspector General receives copy of investigation.
- Professional Standards Unit
  - \*Administrative Investigation for any potential LMPD policy violations.

## 3 Involved Officer(s):

- Officers are placed on paid administrative leave pending investigation.
- Chief has authority to take immediate disciplinary action.
- Prior to returning to duty, officers undergo psychological assessment and receive any necessary training.



## 4 Post-Investigation:

- The LMPD Performance Review Board will conduct a post-incident tactical debrief with all involved members to assess performance improvement and training needs.
- Findings of both criminal and administrative investigations will be made public.
